Lay Pastoral Ministry & Leadership Formation
Programme - Sept 2024 - Dec 2026



The diocese is currently recruiting for a new intake of participants on the Lay Pastoral Ministry and Leadership Formation Programme. The programme is practical and theoretical and involves forming people in prayer and spirituality, pastoral ministry and personal development. It runs for 28 months - typically one weekend per month for 8 months per annum. It is especially for those who may be interested in becoming lay pastoral workers in their parish and pastoral unit.

An Information Evening will take place on Thursday October 3rd at 7.30p.m. in the Limerick Diocesan Centre, Corbally. The deadline for Return of Applications is Wednesday 9th October and the first day takes place on Saturday October 26th from 10.00a.m. to 4.30p.m.
