Weekly Envelope - 2025 order

We will be placing our order for the 2025 Weekly Envelopes'. If you would like to donate to the Parish using this method, please contact the Parish Office. When you are registered, you will receive a supply of 'Weekly Envelopes' which will have a unique number assigned to you, (this allows for your donations to be recording against your name).

This method of donating allows the Parish to maximise the value of your donation; if you donate in excess of €250 per year, the Parish can claim back the tax that you have paid to Revenue under the Charitable Donations Scheme. In order to make a claim under this scheme, the Parish has to have a record of your donations and the Weekly Envelope provides this record.

Donating via bank transfer/standing order also provides a record of your donation. If you would like to donate using this method - we have provided the Church bank details above. Once again, we sincerely thank you for your continued support, we are aware that finances are stretched for many and we very much appreciate your donation.
